


## People again took to the streets to open the cut that was closed by Narhari Ami

Ahmedabad, After the presentation of BJP MP Narhari Amin, the divider cut near Hotel Hillock on the road from Jhundaal to Vaishno Devi on the SP Ring Road of Ahmedabad has been closed by the Auda-Police. Due to which, motorists in areas including New Traged, Chandkheda are facing hardship. Then today (February 8), a signature campaign has been started by local citizens to open the divider cut. People are facing hardship due to having to travel three to four kilometers, so the locals have presented a presentation to Narhari Amin and the corporators to open the cut, but when the problem was not resolved, people once again took to the road. AAP leaders also blocked the road along with locals. People blocked the road on SP Ring Road. Along with the locals, AAP workers including the president of Chandkheda ward and Sabarmati ward of AAP and the president of Chandlodia ward also reached. All the AAP leaders started protesting along with the locals and blocking the road. People blocked the road near Hotel Hillock, creating a traffic jam of more than half a kilometer. Vehicles going from Vaishnodevi Circle to Jhundaal Circle are stuck in the traffic jam. The clash between the residents and the police. On being informed about the incident, a PSI and five policemen from Chandkheda police station rushed to the spot.
